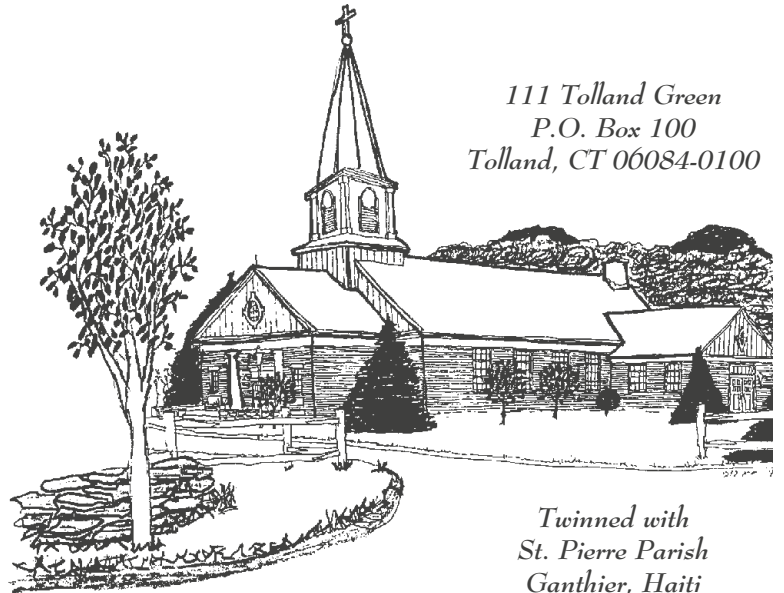

PASTOR'S REFLECTIONS

My Dear Friends in Christ:

Our recent **Parish Trip to Haiti** was a wonderful experience for all. There were four of us on the trip this year: Carol Freedman, John Bouley, Michelle Bouley (John's daughter who is a school teacher in Florida) and myself. We arrived on Wednesday, January 18th and returned home this past Tuesday, January 24th. While in Port-au-Prince, the capitol city, we stayed in the Norwich Diocese Outreach to Haiti Mission House. Since the devastating earthquake on January 12, 2010 which destroyed the previous house, the Diocese has been renting a house in the Petionville section of Port-au-Prince. It is quite comfortable and the Haitian staff make it a very enjoyable place to stay. One of our Norwich Diocesan priests, Father Frank Rouleau, was there to host us and he traveled with us during our visit. Father Frank is assigned to our Haiti Outreach in Port-au-Prince as Director of the Twinning Program. The new pastor of St. Pierre Parish, **Father Antoine Rene**, hosted us for the weekend. When we arrived there on Friday we visited all the classes at St. Pierre School. To our amazement the enrollment has increased to 634 students. The St. Pierre Parish complex sustained minimal damage from the earthquake. Father Rene is a wonderful man and a dedicated priest. We hope to have him come to Tolland for a visit early this fall. We were able to meet up with two gentlemen from River Falls, Wisconsin, Patrick O'Malley and Curt Larsen. They were instrumental in raising the funds for the construction of the new St. Pierre School. They are also raising money to pay teacher salaries in the same way we are doing. Their focus is on the secondary level while ours is with the primary grades. We want to be able to increase our funding because the teachers are not being paid at the proper level for teachers in Haiti. By cooperating with the Wisconsin effort we hope to remedy this situation. 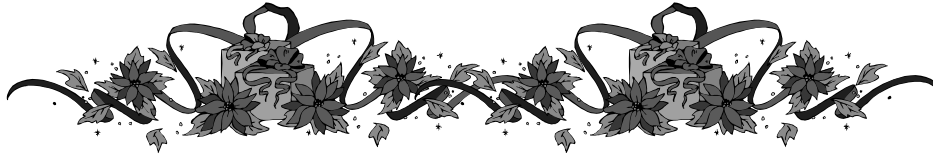
